# Preparation Of Submissions – Guidelines For Entrants

How to Enter - All Awards (excluding Young Freight Forwarder & Apprentice of the Year)

- Go to www.bifa.org/awards
- Read the category descriptions and decide which category/categories your company would like to enter.
- · Complete your company details on page two of this entry form.
- Write your entry submission in the boxes provided on this entry form keeping to the indicated word limits (Introduction: 300 words; Detail of project or service: 600 words; Conclusion: 100 words).
- Save your completed entry form and email to bifaevents@bifa.org no later than 11am Wednesday 2nd October 2024.

#### **Guidelines & Rules for Entries**

- Your submission should detail a relevant service or project such as a specific case study, the development of a new service or a generic example of good practice.
- Entries will be assessed on the following criteria: innovative ideas; service enhancements offered; benefits for the customer; and benefits for the company.
- Do not include any accompanying documents at this time.
- The company must be a BIFA (full or probationary) Trading Member.
- A company may enter a maximum of three categories in each competition year. Each entry must be unique and category specific.
- A company may only enter once per category in each competition year.
- The submission must relate to an international movement of goods (except the Staff Development Award, Specialist Services Award and Sustainable Logistics and the Environment Award).
- The movement of goods need not commence or terminate in the UK, but the UK office must be able to demonstrate control over the service provided.
- Finalist companies will purchase at least one ticket to the BIFA Freight Service Awards Ceremony Luncheon on Thursday 16th January 2025.
- Submissions will be treated in the strictest confidence by BIFA and the Judging panel. An outline of the winning entry in each category will be published as Judges' comments and may be featured in future BIFA publicity material.

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#### **Judging Process**

- After the closing date, all entries will be reviewed at a preliminary judging meeting and a shortlist of finalists in each category will be drawn up.
- All entrants will be contacted during October to advise the outcome of the preliminary judging.
- Shortlisted entrants will be invited to submit supporting documentation (e.g. photos, customer testimonials, statistics)
  to be reviewed by the judging panel. Supporting documentation must be supplied as a single document (Word or pdf file)
  and must not exceed 10 A4 pages.
- · The judging panel will meet in November to select the overall winner for each category.
- The winner of each category will be announced at the BIFA Freight Service Awards 2024 Ceremony Luncheon on Thursday 16th January 2025 (or by alternative means if required owing to circumstances beyond our control).
- · The decision of the judging panel is final.
